

VII. PERSONAL AND PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT

VIII. EMERGENCY AND FIRST AID PROCEDURES

First Aid

EYES: Flush with plenty of water while removing any contact lenses. Continue flushing for 15 minutes. Seek medical attention if irritation persists.

INHALATION: Move to fresh air. Get medical attention.

INGESTION: Rinse mouth with water. Then drink 1-2 glasses of water. Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Seek immediate medical attention.

IX. PREVENTATIVE MEASURES

Steps to be Followed if Spilled or Released: Wear appropriate protective equipment. If possible, contain spill and collect in approved container. Rinse affected area thoroughly with water. Keep product out of storm sewers or waterways. Hold for disposal.

Waste Disposal Methods: Dispose of in accordance with local, state and federal regulations. If possible, triple rinse container, and recycle.

Storage Requirements: Avoid contact with skin or eyes. Avoid breathing vapor, spray or mist. Store in original container, in cool dry place with adequate ventilation. Keep out of reach of children. Keep container tightly closed when not in use.

Other Precautions or Special Hazards: Use only according to label directions. If unsure about safe use, contact your supervisor immediately.
